The Round Performing Arts Centre Social Visual Stories


The Round is a place where I can go and see many things. I might see things that make me laugh, things that make me feel happy and things that can make me feel sad. I can go on my own or with family and friends.




There are big glass doors at the entrance. We might need to wait before we go inside. That's okay because there are gardens to look at and my friends to talk to.






In the foyer is the Box Office. This is a place where I can buy a ticket for the show, or they may look after my bag and jacket.



There are lots of toilets in The Round, and I can ask any of the Staff to help me find them at any time.



All staff will wear black or blue clothes with The Round Logo and have name badges. Their job is to help me if I have questions, or I don't know where to go.

When it's time to go into the auditorium, a staff member called an usher will help me scan my ticket and let me know where I need to sit. I may be sitting next to people I don't know as well as my family or friends.



The show will start once the lights go dark. People will all be facing the front, looking at the stage. Sometimes things might seem sad, scary, or loud. I must remember that what is happening on stage isn't real.




